## Curriculum/State Standard

Standards addressed were in reading and math.

## Overview

Students met twice a week for 45 minutes. They did worksheets dealing with math and reading skills. Answers will be found on the sports cards.

## Objectives

- Students will complete worksheets with a score of 90% or higher. They will work at their own rate.
- Students will obtain a 90% overall grade for this project.

## Materials

Sports trading cards, worksheets, writing utensils

## Readiness Activity

Students were given an introductory lesson on how to read the statistics on baseball and football cards.

## Strategies/Activities

Students were given packets of worksheets dealing with facts about baseball and football. They would use the cards to find out information. Examples: finding a player from each state; alphabetizing countries and names, figuring out averages, etc. Teacher corrected answers and awarded prizes.

## Culminating Activity

Points were kept throughout the 6-week period. At the end of that time, prizes were awarded to the students who had the most correct answers.

## Evaluation

Teacher corrected worksheets and graded them on the accuracy of following directions and finding out the answers.
