Dayton students receive supplies kits

DAYTON — More than 6,500 Dayton Public Schools students will receive kits containing school supplies from the 2006 MeadWestvaco and Lexis-Nexis School Box program.

The program launched Wednesday at Patterson-Kennedy Elementary School, 258 Wyoming St., following a short morning assembly with remarks from program sponsors and Kristine Cohn, U.S. Department of Education senior official for Region V, and distribution of kits.

The remaining kits will be distributed to district students in grades kindergarten through eight.

Each kit contains 30 items, including folders, spiral notebooks, glue, pens, paper, erasers, crayons, pencils, facial tissue, scissors, ruler, markers, colored pencils, pencil sharpener, a pencil case and paint set.
